

All of the UK's "Big Four" banks hold shares in the arms sector: Natwest/RBS (£36.4million), HSBC (£450.6million), Lloyds (£717.5 million) and Barclays (£7.3billion). All have had dealings with known producers of cluster bombs which for over 40 years have killed and injured civilians during and after conflict. On average, a quarter of reported civilian casualties are children. The UN has estimated that of the 4 million cluster bomblets used in South Lebanon, up to 1 million remained unexploded after the conflict ended. The small size and curious shapes of the bomblets dispersed by cluster bombs make them particularly interesting to young people.
